Freeman is Director of the Richmond Symphony Chorus, Artistic Director of Wintergreen Music, Resident Conductor of the Richmond Ballet, and Director of Choral Activities at Virginia Commonwealth University. She has conducted at Carnegie Hall, the Kennedy Center, La Madeleine in Paris, and Boston Symphony Hall, was recently named nominee (2021) and finalist (2019) for Performance Today's Classical Woman of the Year, and has received accolades in *Opera News*, *ClevelandClassical.com*, and *Musicweb-International.com*, among others.
